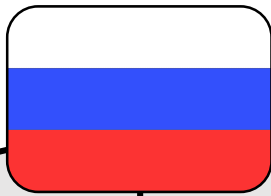




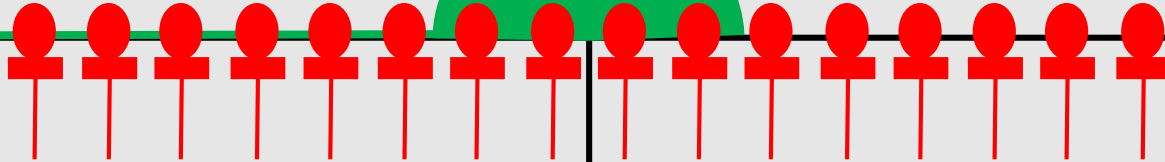
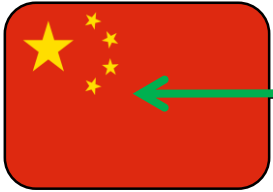


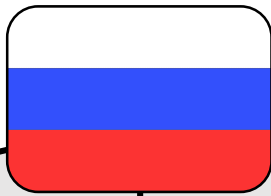
Steer angle

Elevation: 0°



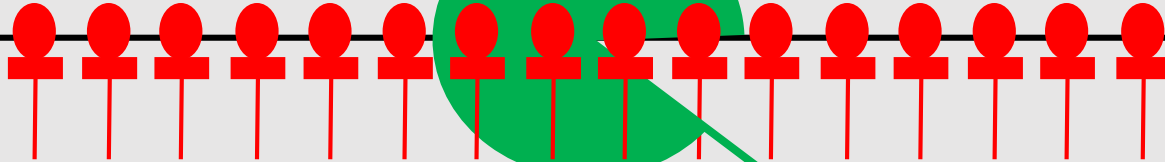
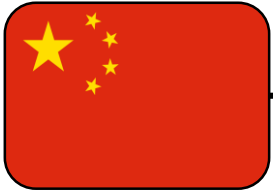


Steer angle
