The table below presents the laboratory schedule. There are four laboratories:

1. Transformer
2. Synchronous machines
3. Asynchronous machines
4. DC machines

Laboratory sessions last at most 4 hours (am: from 8:30 to 12:30; pm: from 13:30 to 17:30). They take place in the "pyramid" (building in front of the cafeteria of Montéfiore). During these laboratories, you will have to follow the steps presented in the laboratory manual (soon available on the course website), student monitors will be present to guide you and answer your questions. You are asked to prepare each lab session by reading carefully beforehand the corresponding part in the lab manual. Note that you will have to answer individually a quick evaluation (focusing only on concepts seen during the laboratory) at the end of each laboratory. Each test represents $3.75 \%$ of your final grade. That is $15 \%$ of the grade for the four laboratories.


An active participation to the laboratories is the best way to experiment and to understand the important concepts of the course. Do not miss this opportunity, you are encouraged to ask questions whenever you encounter difficulties. Please also note that Laboratories are mandatory (In the event of an unexcused absence, an absence grade will be given for the entire course).
